

National Mentorship or National Teaching Award

This Award will alternate each year between a Mentorship or Teaching Award.

That means:

- The Mentorship Award will be presented annually at the ASM, to an outstanding mentor in the infectious diseases/microbiology field
- OR
- The Teaching Award will be presented annually at the ASM to an outstanding early career mentor/teacher in the infectious diseases/microbiology field

Eligibility

The nominee must be a Full Member of ASID at the time of nomination for a minimum of five consecutive years.

Nomination Process

- Nominations can be put forward by any ASID member and must be seconded by a Full Member
- The nomination should be accompanied by emails/letters of support from 3-5 current or recent mentees/students and at least one colleague
- The nominating members should also obtain the nominee's CV and their consent to being nominated
- Nominations will be considered by the Board
- The award will be announced at the ASID ASM
- Applications are to be emailed to submissions@asid.net.au.

The recipient will receive a framed certificate and either free registration for the following year's ASID Annual Scientific Meeting, or a refund for the current meeting. They will also be asked to give an acceptance speech at the ASID ASM.
